The Supreme Court and the Constitution in a Civil Society

Anthony M. Kennedy is an American lawyer and jurist who served as the 93rd Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States from 1988 until retiring in 2018.

Born in Sacramento, Anthony Kennedy received his bachelor's degree in political science from Stanford University. Kennedy went on to graduate from Harvard Law School and teach constitutional law. He subsequently served a year in the California Army National Guard.

Kennedy joined the U.S. Court of Appeals in the mid-'70s and in 1988, after being appointed by Ronald Reagan, became a Supreme Court Justice. Initially known for his conservative views, he became the court's prominent swing vote over his 30 years on the bench.

Kennedy has tended to look at cases individually instead of deciding them on the basis of a rigid ideology. Kennedy has been active off the bench as well, calling for reform of overcrowded American prisons in a speech before the American Bar Association.
